About RNIDS

The Register of National Internet Domain Names of Serbia (RNIDS) is a professional, non-governmental, not-for-profit foundation established to manage the .rs and .cp6 country code top-level Internet domains in a way that serves the general interests of all Serbian citizens while adhering to the principles of quality, efficiency, independence and transparency.

The RNIDS Founding Assembly was held on the **8 July 2006** and this day is marked as RNIDS Day. RNIDS operated as a fund until the 28 May 2011 when it became a foundation in accordance with law.

The corporate structure of RNIDS comprises the **Conference of Co-founders**, the **Board of Governors** and the **Director**. Any legal entity or sole trader who pays the annual fee, signs the Agreement and appoints an authorised representative to the RNIDS Conference of Co-founders can become a RNIDS co-founder.

RNIDS manages the register for the country code top-level Internet domain of the Republic of Serbia, .rs, in accordance with the decision of ICANN dated 11 September 2007. On the 8th of November 2010, ICANN accepted RNIDS's proposal that .cp6 become the Cyrillic domain of Serbia and assigned this label to our country as the second country code top-level Internet domain.

Serbian Internet Domain Day (DIDS) is held on **10 March**, the day in 2008 when the registration of the .RS domain officially began.

The **primary objective of RNIDS** is to manage the register of national Internet domains. RNIDS manages five domains in each of the two country code top-level domains (.RS, CO.RS, ORG.RS, EDU.RS and IN.RS, as well as .CPB, ПР.СРВ, OPГ.СРВ, OBР.СРВ and OД.СРВ). The management of the second-level domains AC.RS and AKM.CPB has been delegated to the Academic Network of Serbia and the management of GOV.RS and YПР.СРВ to the Administration for Joint Services of the Republic Bodies.

Additional objectives of RNIDS are:

- 1) Increasing the number of RNIDS co-founders and involving the wider community in its work;
- 2) Promoting the Internet as a public resource available to all citizens:
- 3) Increasing Internet content in Serbian and the languages of national minorities.

About Belgrade

Belgrade is the capital city of **Serbia** and has a population of around 1.7 million. It is one of the oldest cities in Europe and has since ancient times been an important crossing of the ways where the roads of eastern and western Europe meet. The city lies on two international waterways, at the confluence of the **Sava** and **Danube** rivers which surround it on three sides. Because of this position, Belgrade is fittingly referred to as the Gateway to the Balkans and the Door to Central Europe.

The oldest archaeological finds in this area date from the 5th millennium BC. The site of Vinča, which preserves traces of a prehistoric human material culture (Neolithic plastic art), is located on the banks of the Danube. Belgrade's rivers have a total of 200 km of riverbank and 16 river islands, of which Ada Ciganlija and the Great War Island are the largest.

Belgrade is geographically comprised of three areas: the Old Town on the right bank of the Sava and Danube, New Belgrade on the left bank of the Sava, and Zemun on the banks of the Danube behind New Belgrade. Belgrade Fortress is the oldest cultural and historical site in Belgrade. Also of interest to tourists are Skardarlija, the central bohemian quarter; the Residence of Princess Ljubica; Captain Miša's Building; the Old Palace and New Palace; the Serbian National Assembly building and the Cathedral of Saint Sava.
