## .CPB has arrived!

The Cyrillic Internet domain .CPB is a new, second country code Top Level Domain of the Republic of Serbia and it belongs to the family of Internationalized Domain Names, IDNs, i.e. domain names which are not written in English alphabet. The largest countries and nations in the world, Russia and China, already have IDNs in their national scripts and lots of Arabian countries are already using domains in Arabian script.

The .CPB domain became visible on the Internet as of **3 May 2011**, after IANA (Internet Assigned Numbers Authority) had reached a decision to delegate its management to RNIDS. The open registration of the .CPB domain is expected to begin in autumn and bodies of RNIDS are working on the necessary software and registration procedures.

**The subdomain structure** within the .CPB domain is identical to the existing subdomains within the .RS domain:

.RS domain	.CPB domain	Explanation

The following names were proposed for delegated domains:

Besides 30 letters of the Serbian Cyrillic (a-ш), **Serbian Cyrillic Internet domain names** can include digits (0-9) and a dash (-). They cannot contain a dash in the beginning or the end or two consecutive dashes in the third and fourth position.

A .CPB domain name may contain a maximum of 63 ASCII characters after ACE-compatible conversion.

## What are advantages of the .CPB domain?

### 1. The only Internet domain in the world where Internet addresses are written exactly as they are pronounced.

Thanks to the peculiarity of the Serbian Cyrillic where one phoneme matches one letter, addresses under the .CPB domain will unequivocally be pronounced exactly as they are written, unlike for instance numerous domain names in the English alphabet.

### 2. Fulfilment of the constitutional right of the citizens of Serbia to be able to use Internet domain names in their official script.

At a time when the right to the Internet is considered to be a basic human right in developed countries, when even the largest countries in the world are concerned with preserving their national identity through domain names in their script, Serbia was among the first ones to make a step towards establishing a domain in its national script.


### 3. Timely occupation of available Internet space for future needs.

The development of the Internet is such that very soon almost every person will have to have their own Internet identity. It has already become necessary for companies and organisations. Since many terms and names are occupied within existent Internet domain spaces, the introduction of the .CPB domain represents timely occupation of available Internet space for various future requirements that are currently unpredictable. There are serious assumptions that in the future even many devices we use day in day out will have their own Internet address. Here's a futuristic example: your digitalised car with address 'мојаљутамашина.срб' makes an appointment with a mechanic itself for a service inspection and oil replacement.



# About RNIDS

The Register of National Internet Domain Names of Serbia (RNIDS) is an expert, non-governmental and non-profit Foundation established for the purpose of managing the country code Top Level Domains .RS and .CPB, so that general interest of all citizens of Serbia is satisfied, along with fulfilling principles of quality, efficiency, independence and transparency.

RNIDS has **54 co-founders** and **34 registrars**. More than **66,000 .RS domain names** are currently registered in **five address spaces** (.rs, .co.rs, .org.rs, .in.rs and .edu.rs). The **Cyrillic domain .CPB** is under the process of testing at the moment.

# Programme of support to Internet popularisation projects

The Register of National Internet Domain Names of Serbia will allocate non-refundable assets to projects complying with the general aims and activities of the Foundation, just like last year. The objective of **2011 Programme of support to Internet popularisation projects** is to promote the Internet as a publicly available resource, available to and required by all citizens of Serbia, and increase the scope of useful Internet content both in the Serbian language and languages of national minorities.

All legal entities or entrepreneurs registered in the Republic of Serbia and fulfilling general and specific conditions can apply for using non-refundable assets from the Programme of support to Internet popularisation projects. Proposed projects have to comply with the general aims and activities of RNIDS and the Strategy of developing the information society in the Republic of Serbia.

The assets available for implementing the Programme of support to Internet popularisation projects amount to **6,000,000 RSD**. The amount of approved assets cannot be lower than 100,000 RSD or larger than 1,000,000 RSD. The deadline for applying in the first round of the programme is **31 July 2011**. In case RNIDS Commission does not allocate all available assets, it will be possible to apply in the second round of the programme of support to Internet popularisation projects until 1 October 2011.

# Regular session of RNIDS Assembly



A regular session of RNIDS Assembly took place on **28 May** at the Serbian Internet Domain Home. Thirty-seven members and more than 20 guests and media representatives attended the session.

The **Statute** of the Register of National Internet Domain Names of Serbia was ratified at the session. It complies with the Law on Endowments and Foundations applicable as of 1 March 2011. According to the new Statute, RNIDS remains the same legal entity but a new managing body, the **Conference of Co-founders**, is introduced and it takes the largest part of responsibilities of RNIDS Assembly, whilst a part of responsibilities is taken by the Managing Board. What is also new is that the same person cannot be a member of the Managing Board and an authorised representative of a member of the Conference of Co-founders.

The Assembly also ratified the **Rules on the Beginning of Operation of .CPB Registry and General Terms and Conditions for Registration of .CPB Domain Names**, thus establishing conditions for the initiation of software and procedural preparations for registering the new Cyrillic country code Top Level Domain of Serbia.

2010 report on the work of the Director, the report on the work of the Managing Board from May 2010 to May 2011 and the report of the Chairman of the Assembly on activities of the Assembly in last two years were also ratified at the regular session of RNIDS Assembly.

This is the first Assembly session that took part in the premises of RNIDS, the **Serbian Internet Domain Home**.

# New website of RNIDS

The new official website of RNIDS was launched on **11 May** and besides its old address [www.rnids.rs](http://www.rnids.rs) it is also available under the new Cyrillic country code Top Level Domain, at [рнидс.срб](http://рнидс.срб). At the same time, you may test the application of this innovation within the Serbian part of the Internet at this location.

The new website of RNIDS has approximately one hundred basic web pages in Cyrillic and Latin, along with a version in English. Apart from information on activities, bodies and the organisation of RNIDS, as well as registrars, it also contains useful advice for users of .rs domain names. Visitors are also provided with the possibility of accessing the Whois database on registered domain names.

The website contains a news archive with news from 2007 to date, a photo and video gallery, as well as an events calendar with significant events from the field of the Internet both in Serbia and abroad. Communication with visitors is enabled in a number of ways on the site itself, as well as through Twitter and Facebook. You can also find links to important local and foreign websites. The website complies with standards on e-accessibility for people with special needs.



# Who does my Internet domain belong to?

A roundtable discussion with the topic 'Who does my Internet domain belong to?' took place on **14 June** at the Serbian Internet Domain Home, where the **Rulebook on Arbitrage Proceedings for Settling Disputes Arising out of the Registration of .rs Domains** and the Cooperation Agreement between the Serbian Chamber of Commerce and the Register of National Internet Domain Names of Serbia were presented.

The Rulebook regulates proceedings before the **Commission for Settling Disputes**, established under the Serbian Chamber of Commerce. It complies with the principles of ICAAN's Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Process (UDRP) and the .eu Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR EU) rules.

The new Rulebook became effective on 17 May 2011. One of the major changes compared to the previous document is that the decision of the Commission for Settling Disputes Arising out of the Registration of .rs Domains needs not be final, since after

the decision of the Commission the parties can also address a regular court in order to settle their dispute.

Mr **Dušan Popović**, the President of the Commission for Settling Disputes Arising out of the Registration of .rs Domains and Mr **Marko Jovanović**, the Vice President of the Commission, spoke at the roundtable discussion. The discussion was opened by Mr Vladimir Đelić, the Secretary of the Commission, and Mr Dejan Đukić, the Manager of Legal Affairs with RNIDS. More than 30 participants attended the convention which was moderated by Mr Slobodan Marković. The roundtable discussion was organised by RNIDS and the Serbian Chamber of Commerce.

## Domain Star Facebook game



# Invitation to new co-founders

RNIDS is an open organisation and the number of its co-founders continuously increases. One of the aims of RNIDS is to **include the broadest social community in the operation of RNIDS**. Thus, we would like to invite all professionals within the local Internet community, interested in the wellbeing of the local Internet space, to become co-founders of RNIDS.

All interested subjects registered with official registries of **legal entities and entrepreneurs** of the Republic of Serbia can join RNIDS, thus becoming co-founders of the Foundation. The decision on the accession of new co-founders is brought by the Managing Board of RNIDS, upon which the Accession Agreement is enclosed with the Director of RNIDS. After signing, the Agreement is submitted to the Serbian Business Registers Agency for the purpose of entering the new co-founder into the Registry of Endowments and Foundations.

Co-founders pay the **annual fee**, which currently amounts to **12,000 RSD**, and they are also obliged to delegate an authorised representative who will participate in activities of **RNIDS Conference of Co-founders** on their behalf.
